## Post-doctoral Fellowships Available in Kidney, Urological & Hematological Research

We are seeking applications for training investigators in the fields of benign **kidney**, **urology & hematology**. We have brought together expertise in research and education to establish the New York Consortium for Interdisciplinary Training in Kidney, Urological, and Hematological Research (KUHR: pronounced "cure").

The fellowships, funded by the NIH, allow interdisciplinary training with world class investigators across 4 prestigious New York Research Institutions.

Applications now being accepted for 2-3-year post-doctoral training grants starting July 1st 2024. Both applicants & mentors should submit application documents here by March 15, 2024 at 11:59 PM ET.

- Applicants should submit 1 PDF which includes:
  - An NIH biosketch for the applicant
  - An NIH biosketch for the mentor
  - Personal statement (maximum 1 page) detailing previous research experiences, career aspirations and a training plan
  - Research proposal (maximum 1 page) detailing the specific aims to be accomplished during funding period with a timeline (please contact us if unsure of project at the time of submission)
- For each applicant, 2 letters of recommendation should be uploaded by the letter writer
  - At least 1 should be from a current or former research mentor
  - The mentor letter should include a mentoring plan for the trainee
