Post-doctoral Fellowships Available in Kidney, Urological & Hematological Research

We are seeking applications for training investigators in the fields of **kidney, benign urology & benign hematology**. We have brought together expertise in research and education to establish the New York Consortium for Interdisciplinary Training in Kidney, Urological, and Hematological Research (KUHR: pronounced “cure”).

The NIH funded pre- and post-doctoral training grants allow interdisciplinary training with world class investigators across 4 prestigious New York Research Institutions.

The application for the post-doctoral training grants is open for applicants and mentors to submit documents [here](#) by 03/17/25 at 11:59 PM ET. Eligible applicants will be interviewed for the award starting 07/01/25.

- **Applicants should submit 1 PDF which includes:**
 - NIH biosketch for the applicant
 - NIH biosketch for the mentor
 - Personal statement (maximum 1 page) detailing previous research experiences, career aspirations and a training plan
 - Research proposal (maximum 1 page) detailing the specific aims to be accomplished during the funding period with a timeline

- **For each applicant, 2 letters of recommendation should be uploaded by the letter writer**
 - At least 1 should be from a current or former research mentor
 - The mentor letter should include a mentoring plan for the trainee and the mentor is required to complete CIMER training before or during the funding period
