

## Summer Undergraduate Research Internship Program 2025

The NYC Train KUHR program invites undergraduate students in science programs to apply for a sponsored summer research internship.

## **Eligibility:**

- Primary: Students enrolled at City University of New York (CUNY) and other institutions within the greater New York City area.
- **Secondary:** Students from outside the NYC area are eligible to apply, but must be able to commute to one of the host laboratories as the program does not provide housing.

## **Host Laboratories:**

- Albert Einstein College of Medicine
- Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai
- · Columbia University Irving Medical Center
- Renaissance School of Medicine at Stony Brook University

The Summer Undergraduate Research Internship Program (SURIP) of the NYC Train KUHR provides the opportunity for students to learn new techniques, methods and approaches that are commonly used in basic, clinical, and translational kidney, urological and hematological (KUH) research. The program welcomes students who are:

- New to research and have an interest in learning about KUH research and/or in applying a new method, technique, or experimental approach in the KUH field.
- Experienced with prior research experience with an interest in learning about KUH research.

The overall goal of this program is to increase the awareness of undergraduate students to KUH research and opportunity for future MD, PhD or MD/PhD training in basic, clinical, and translational research in the NYC Train KUHR TL1 training program or other training programs.

**Internship duration:** Students are expected to participate in the program for 8 to 9 weeks, with an expected start date in the first week of June 2025.

**Funding:** Selected candidates will receive a **stipend of up to \$3,000** that will be calculated based on time spent in the program. Funds are to be used to pay for the students' time to conduct research in one of the KUH areas during the Summer.
